Dr. Kemp worked for Dean Health System for more than 27 years, first as clinical anesthesiologist and then as physician administrator. He later served in several key executive roles, including chair of Dean Medical Center; chair of Dean Health Plan; and chief executive officer/board chair for Dean Health System. During his time at Dean Health System, Dr. Kemp led the implementation of their new electronic health records system. Dr. Kemp also served on the board of directors of the American Medical Group Association (AMGA) from 2000 to 2008; and served as chair in 2007. He has also served as a director on the AMGA foundation board from 2008 to 2016. In addition, Dr. Kemp served as the interim senior associate dean at Columbia University Medical Center in New York, N.Y. during 2010.
